



Rockwoods Road parking restrictions

Dear Parent/Carer

As we embark on a new academic year, can I please take this opportunity to remind parents of students who are dropped off and picked up on Rockwoods Road that there are parking restrictions in place which must be complied with. Traffic Enforcement Officers are on duty to ensure that this is the case.

These restrictions have been put in place as a traffic calming measure, in the main to reduce the negative impact that inappropriate and, at times, illegal parking have had on the day to day lives of residents on Rockwoods Road.

Can I please ask that you adhere to the restrictions in place and, in doing so, show the courtesy that local residents in our community should be entitled to.

To further help traffic flow, for those that are new to Priesthorpe, there operates an informal one-way system before and after school, whereby cars drive along Rockwoods Road from the direction of Woodhall Road. This helps enormously in terms of congestion, and avoids the need for what, at times, can be extremely dangerous driving, with cars mounting pavements and putting pedestrians at significant risk.
