



Geography Field Trip

Dear Parent/Carer,

As part of the Geography course all GCSE Geography students studying the subject are required to undertake 2 field trips. The data collected on these field trips, and the subsequent investigation and write up, will be examined in the summer of 2019 as part of their GCSE. Overall, the field work component is worth 15% of all their GCSE marks.

The second field trip will take place on **Thursday 24th January 2019**; all students in the 11w1 and 11w2 groups will be expected to attend. The purpose of the trip is to collect data on the regeneration of the Ancoats area of Manchester. In order for the trip to run, we ask for a voluntary contribution of £10 to be paid.

Travel to Manchester will be by coach and **we will depart from Co-op Academy Priesthorpe at 8:30am**. All students must therefore meet outside the staff/student entrance to the academy at 8.15. **We will return at approximately 15:30**. Students should wear outdoor footwear and a waterproof jacket. In addition, students will need a packed lunch, a pen, pencil and a small rucksack. If your child is entitled to a free school meal and would like a lunch provided they must let me know by Monday 14th January.

The confirmation slip, voluntary contribution and E1 form needs to be returned by Friday 11th January 2019. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact me.
